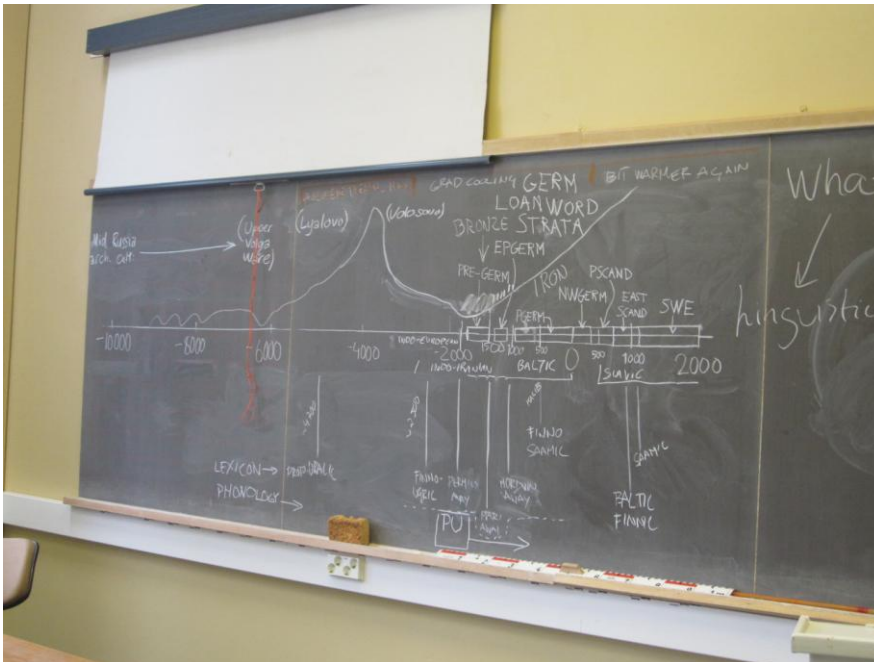


Figure 1. Seminar summed up.
